# CAMP CHATUGA

## 2016 INFORMATION

PLEASE READ THIS PAGE CAREFULLY

**ADMISSION:** Boys and girls going into grades 1-11. Mini-Camp is for rising 1<sup>st</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> graders only.

**RISING 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> GRADERS** do NOT register online or with this application. They *must* apply to be a Leader-in-Training (rising 10<sup>th</sup> grade) or Service Camper (rising 11<sup>th</sup> grade); they get discounted fees in exchange for some work. Please request the LIT/SC application as this fills quickly.

**OPEN HOUSE:** You may visit our facilities any Monday through Saturday on your own. Open House is in the spring. Check website for exact date.

**FEES:** Our fee is ALL-INCLUSIVE: tuition, all activities, room and board, t-shirt, canteen treats, ground transportation from Greenville/Spartanburg (GSP) airport (except one-week sessions), trip admissions and meals (two-, three- and four-week sessions), postage for letters home. There is an optional additional fee for parents to access camp's photo blog and to email your camper.

**DISCOUNTS:** Early enrollment discount of \$50 for all applications and deposits postmarked by December 15, sibling discount of \$25 after the first child, and discounts for Leaders-in-Training and Service Campers, who must fill out an LIT/SC application. (Look on our website for a printable copy.) Contact us for how you can earn discounts for recruiting new campers.

**BILLING:** A \$450 deposit for 2-, 3- or 4-week sessions or a \$200 deposit for 1-week sessions must accompany each application and will be credited to tuition. Payments may be made monthly or in one sum. Final payment is due before your session begins. If enrolling after May 1, send payment in full. We accept checks, debit cards and most credit cards.

**REFUNDS:** Your deposit and tuition are fully refundable if you must cancel. We do deduct a \$50 processing fee. Please note that if you don't notify us of a cancellation, all monies paid will be forfeited. If a camper is sent home for behavior, there will be no refund.

**TRANSPORTATION:** For Opening and Closing Day times, check website. We meet airline flyers at the Greenville/Spartanburg Airport (GSP) ONLY; car riders may also meet us there for two-, three- or four-week sessions. The airport is 1½ hours from camp. Book flights to arrive and depart between 10:00am and 2:30pm. A \$75 fee per family will be added for times that fall outside of this time frame.

**INFORMATION PACKAGE:** You will receive an email including your Parent Handbook before your session begins. Health form and clothing list may be obtained from our website at [www.campchatuga.com](http://www.campchatuga.com).

**CAMPER GUIDELINES:** All campers must read (or have read to them) the Camper Guidelines (sent to camper in information packet). When you agree to the waiver, you are stating that your camper has read and agrees to abide by the regulations outlined in the Guidelines.

**ACTIVITIES:** Activities are all included in the tuition, including horseback, waterski and crafts. Campers pick their own activities from over thirty choices when they arrive to camp. Mini-Camp campers will be sent an activity form to fill out and return before arriving for their session.

**TRIPS:** All campers in Sessions A, C, CD1 and CD get a trip that emphasizes experiences a camper cannot easily find at home. Depending on the camper's number of years at Chatuga, trips may include visiting Stumphouse Tunnel, innertubing or swimming on the Chattooga River, viewing Tallulah Gorge, rafting on the Nantahala River, taking a canopy zipline tour, or rafting Section 3 of the Chattooga River. Trip for **Session D** (also the second trip for Session CD) is an all-camp rollerskating party. No trip in one-week sessions, except for Session D2 which goes rollerskating. We recommend \$15-\$20 extra spending money for these trips.

**HEALTH:** Health form must be submitted three weeks prior to attending camp. Chatuga's infirmary, with a full-time health supervisor, provides for onsite needs. Health needs that require doctor's visits, prescriptions, x-rays, or emergency room visits will be billed to parents.

**LOCATION:** Chatuga is ten miles northwest of Walhalla off Hwy. 28 in the northwestern corner of SC (five miles from GA and five miles from NC). Two hours north of Atlanta; 1½ hours west of Greenville, SC; 3 hours southwest of Charlotte.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** The camp reserves the right to use any photographs, videos, writings, quotations, etc. of campers, staff and parents to promote Chatuga. Camp Chatuga is not responsible for personal belongings and money while in transit or in camp or if lost or damaged by fire, theft, etc.
